2. Qualitative & Quantitative Composition

Svarjiksara (Shudh) and Nimbukamlam (Shushkam) as per label declaration on each flavor pack

3. Dosage Form

Powder to be dissolved in water before consumption

4. Clinical Particulars

4.1 Indications/Uses

For relieving acidity

The product is effective for the symptomatic relief of:

- Heartburn
- Acid indigestion
- Sour stomach
- Upset stomach due to these symptoms

4.2. Posology and method of administration

For oral administration only.

For use in Adults and children aged 12 years and over:

5 g (one sachet or one teaspoonful of powder) dissolved in a glass (~150 ml) of water. Drink as symptoms occur. Repeat after 2-3 hours, if necessary.

Minimum dosing interval: 2 hours.

Maximum Daily Dose (MDD): Do not take more than 2 doses in 24 hours. Do not take this medicine for more than 14 days at Maximum Daily Dose (MDD). Not recommended for Children under 12 years of age.

4.3 Contraindications

Do not use if: you are on low salt diet, have high blood pressure, Congestive heart failure, have impaired hepatic and renal function or are allergic to any of the ingredients.

4.4 Warnings and Precautions

- Do not exceed the stated dose as excess or prolong use may lead to alkalosis.
- Consult doctor if symptoms persist or worsen.
- Keep out of reach and sight of children.

This product reduces the acidity of your stomach and may interfere with how other medications are absorbed – therefore, please take other medications at a different time of the day.

4.5 Interaction with other medicaments and other forms of interaction

The acid neutralizing action of the product may alter the absorption profile of pH specific drugs given concomitantly.

If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, please consult your doctor before taking this product.
